**10.2 Information: Health Workforce Pilot Project (HWPP) # 173 Community Paramedicine Approval with Modifications.**

Notification November 14, 2014 letter to Dr. Becker MD, MPH, Director Emergency Services Authority was notified by OSHPD Director Robert P. David that Health Workforce Pilot Project (HWPP) #173 could go forward with staff recommendations for modifications:

- Transport patients with specified conditions to alternate locations other than acute care emergency hospitals
- Address the needs of frequent 9-1-1 callers or frequent visitors to emergency departments
- Provide short-term home follow-up care for persons recently discharged from the hospital and at increased risk of a return visit to the emergency department or readmission to a hospital
- Provide short-term home support for persons with diabetes, asthma, congestive heart failure, or multiple chronic conditions.

Staff Liaison to continue following implementation of Community Paramedicine, Health Workforce Pilot Project and report findings to the Practice Committee.

**10.3 Review and Vote Whether to Recommend to Approve Goals and Objectives 2015-2016 to provide for continuing information on Nursing Practice in California**
