



## NOTICE OF PROPOSED EMERGENCY REGULATIONS

### To All Interested Parties:

Government Code section 11346.1, as amended by AB 302, Chapter 73, Statutes of 2006, requires that an adopting agency provide a notice of the proposed emergency action to every person who has filed a request for notice of regulatory action with the agency. The notice shall be provided to those persons at least five working days before submitting an emergency regulation to the Office of Administrative Law.


Attached are the proposed emergency regulations by the Board of Registered Nursing relating to non-fingerprinted licensee population. The proposed regulations also require the disclosure of any convictions as a condition of renewal, activating an inactive license, or reinstatement of an expired license. Also attached is the Board's Finding of Emergency.

The Board plans to have a hearing on these regulations in the very near future and will send out notices as soon as the date of the hearing is determined.
