Updated Information

The Informative Digest and Initial Statement of Reasons are included in the rulemaking file and incorporated as though set forth herein.

This rulemaking package was noticed on March 14, 2025, and the 45-day comment period was through April 28, 2025. No public hearing was originally set for this proposal, and no public hearing was requested. No comments were received.

Objections or Recommendations/Responses

There were no objections or recommendations regarding the proposed action.

Local Mandate

A mandate is not imposed on local agencies or school districts.

Consideration of Alternatives

No reasonable alternative which was considered or that has otherwise been identified and brought to the attention of the Board would be more effective in carrying out the purpose for which it was proposed or would be as effective and less burdensome to affected private persons than the adopted regulations or would be more cost effective to affected private persons and equally effective in implementing the statutory policy or other provisions of law. The Board incorporates by reference the alternatives identified in its Initial Statement of Reasons and did not receive any comments that altered its findings.

Incorporation by Reference

The proposed regulations incorporate by reference NONPF's Nurse Practitioner Role Core Competencies Content (2022). The document incorporated by reference in this

rulemaking would be cumbersome, unduly expensive and otherwise impractical to publish in the CCR because of the document's length and use of table formatting which is not conducive to inclusion in the CCR.
